Farmington High School serves the town of Farmington, NH with a population of approximately 6,800 residents. This is a rural community located in southeastern New Hampshire and approximately 80 miles north of Boston. Farmington High School is a comprehensive public school serving approximately 250 students in grades 9 through 12. Farmington's curriculum also includes CTE program offerings through the Lakes Region Technology Center. Farmington runs on a 4x4 block schedule. Some classes may run as a year-long skinny class or a year-long block. Classes meet Monday through Friday for 83 minutes per block/45 minutes per skinny, plus a 30-minute enrichment period. Semester and skinny courses are 1 credit each and full year blocks are 2 credits each.
