VLACS Course Approval Form:

Virtual Learning Academy Charter School (VLACS) is a fully accredited virtual high school in which students have the opportunity to take courses and earn credit at no additional cost. Students wishing to enroll in a VLACS course must submit their request for approval. Approval is granted by the building Principal and will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Approval is generally granted if:

- There is a conflict with the students schedule that prevents them from taking a core course at FHS
- There is a course on VLACS that is not offered at FHS
- The student is taking the course for credit recovery
- The student wants to take the course at a higher level than what is offered at FHS

Other considerations include, but are not limited to:

- Course timeline and pacing: Proposed start and finish dates should be realistic and appropriate for the student. *Please keep in mind that it can take up to 2 weeks to begin a course so students need to plan ahead. Seniors wishing to take a course on VLACS should plan to have the course completed by May 25th to ensure that the credit gets recorded on their transcript.
- **Graduation requirements**: Is the requested course part of a graduation requirement?
- Are you a self-motivated learner? We have found that students who experience the most success with VLACS courses are those who are: self-motivated, independent workers, effective at time management, diligent about completing tasks, and can effectively self-advocate.
- Access to technology: Do you have consistent access to a computer, internet, and other course specific requirements that may apply?
